DESCRIPTION: Offering free and confidential testing through community events, by appointment and Wednesday evenings in our Uptown office (5 to 7 PM) in partnership with the Health Department.

- Our outreach team performed 147 HIV tests and everyone tested was referred for follow up interventions depending on their individual needs.
- Through our partnership with the Mecklenburg County Health Department, we provided office space for them to perform HIV/STI tests for an additional 236 people for a total of 383. This partnership allows easy access for people working in the uptown area as well as the community's homeless population.
