



About the Luncheon


The 12th Annual World AIDS Day Luncheon is a meaningful and inspiring event focused on supporting people living with HIV and those at risk. On Thursday, December 4, our community will gather at The Casey to honor lives lost, raise awareness, and learn how RAIN is working to end HIV in our region.

World AIDS Day, observed each year on December 1, was established in 1988 as the first global health day. It's a time to remember those lost to AIDS-related illnesses, show solidarity with those living with HIV, and recommit to ending the epidemic.

Today, more than 38 million people around the world, including 1.2 million in the U.S., live with HIV. Here in Mecklenburg County, hundreds are diagnosed each year. While medical advances and legal protections have improved outcomes, stigma, misinformation, and health disparities still create barriers to care.

World AIDS Day reminds us: HIV is not over. Raising awareness, promoting education, and fighting stigma remain vital in protecting our community and building a healthier future.

RAIN's World AIDS Day Luncheon is more than a fundraiser, it's a day of unity, reflection, and hope. Together, we can ensure that every person living with HIV receives the respect, care, and support they deserve. Your presence and support help make this vision a reality.





Since 1992, RAIN has been a trusted leader in delivering compassionate, comprehensive HIV services with integrity and a commitment to achieving meaningful outcomes.

We serve a diverse community, from youth as young as 13 to adults living with or at risk for HIV. Our work goes beyond critical services: we're dedicated to breaking the stigma through education, advocacy, and empowering individuals to challenge HIV-related discrimination wherever it appears.

Accessibility and inclusivity are at the heart of our mission. We offer services in person and via telehealth to meet people where they are, and we provide care in both English and Spanish to reflect the linguistic diversity of our community.

At RAIN, advocacy knows no boundaries. We fight for the rights and dignity of all people living with HIV, regardless of race, gender identity, immigration status, or sexual orientation. Equality a nd justice are not just values — they are the foundation of everything we do.
